

CHAPTER 5.00 - STUDENTS

FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Procedures for implementing the foreign exchange student program is as follows:

- (a) Is at least fifteen (15) years or age but has not attained the age of eighteen and one-half (18 ½) years of age at the time of enrollment. Proof of age must be documented by a birth certificate or passport.
- (b) Provides an academic transcript from the home school with English translation.
- (c) Provides evidence of sufficient English proficiency to function successfully in the academic level in which he/she is enrolled.
- (d) Meets immunization requirements in accordance with Florida statutes.
- (e) Has health, accident and liability insurance coverage that is valid in the United States.
- (f) A student shall be enrolled for a semester or a complete school year [two (2) semesters].
- (g) The student shall be subject to the *Code of Student Conduct*.
- (h) The student shall be subject to the *Student Progression Plan*.
- (i) Eligibility for participation in athletics shall be consistent with Florida High School Athletic Association and School Board rules.
